“Thank you for allowing me a forum on which to express my beliefs with regard to this important matter.

The former administration has crippled us and has left us on our knees in financial straits. The extent of the damage the former mayor has dealt to the city of Winnipeg may not be recognized for *even up to 18 months*, so it will take time to fulfill our dreams. To blindly endorse **any** financial commitment without a good handle on the City of Winnipeg’s actual financial situation is irresponsible and goes against logical thinking.

One of the most important things I believe I can do for safety in Winterpeg, Manisnowba is to push hard for 50 new pieces of snow clearing equipment so that we can actually **walk** on the sidewalks. I have been appalled at the sight of goat trails little children are forced onto because of the apparent lack of sufficient caring on the part of the incumbent Councillor. My experience and training with Emergency Services has taught me that every dollar spent in preventing injury saves seven. At the University of Winnipeg’s Bike Lab Advocacy session, I learned that for every dollar invested in active transportation, twenty-four are made in municipal benefit. Armed with knowledge of the financial benefits alone of active transportation investment (never mind the physical/sociological/environmental/etc ones) will help me convince the other elected members of the wisdom of strengthened financial support for such projects.”
